

S&SHAC London Marathon Club Entry Policy

The person applying for a London Marathon club place must have been a fully paid up first claim member of S&SHAC for at least 12 months prior to the club place draw.

The member applying for a club place must be a minimum of 18 years old & must have applied for a London Marathon ballot place.

A member who has previously received the club place is not eligible for the place for 3 years unless they are the only applicant.

The member wishing to be considered for the club place will have been notified that they have not been successful in obtaining a ballot place. They must provide proof that they have been unsuccessful & register their desire to be considered for a club place by notifying the club secretary and club nominated administrator.

The names of members who have been: -

1. unsuccessful in obtaining a ballot place,
2. have registered their desire to take a club place &
3. meet the criteria set out in this policy

will be entered into a draw.

The member who wishes to be considered for the club place can increase their chances of their name being drawn through competing or volunteering for the club.

Events eligible for competing for the club are midland track & field league races, team road relay races, Birmingham league cross country races, Midland women's cross country league races, Warwickshire cross country championships & Midland area cross country championships.

Events eligible for volunteering for the club are all the above where the club is required to provide a volunteer plus any event where the club is the host club e.g YDL, HoE League, Balsall Common 10k etc

Each occurrence of competing or volunteering will add an additional entry with their name on into the draw.

Upon notification of a successful application for club place(s) the equivalent number of name(s) will be randomly selected in a draw.

The draw will take place as soon as is possible to arrange it after the club has been notified of how many places they have been allocated.

The drawn name(s) will be notified that they have obtained a club place & the club secretary or nominated administrator will enter the members details onto the

London Marathon system so they can complete the online application process.

It is the members responsibility to pay and complete the on-line registration process by the club entries deadline (usually mid January).

The succesful member(s) will be representing the club & as such is/are expected to wear club colours during the race.
